

REFERENCES

Reference or **References** is centered bolded at the top of its own page. Sources are in hanging paragraph format. List sources in alphabetical order by the author's last name or by title if there is not an author.

Book and Article Titles only the first word of the title, subtitle and proper nouns are capitalized. Article titles are not enclosed in quote marks.

ONE AUTHOR

Books-Print

Author, A.A. (Year). *Title of the book: Subtitle of the book*, (Edition). Publisher.

Books-EBooks

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Journal Article – Print

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Journal Article – Database

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MULTIPLE AUTHORS

Two to Twenty Authors List each author's last name, initials separated by commas. Proceed the last author's name with an ampersand "&."

More Than Twenty Authors List the first 19 authors' last names and initials. Use ellipses ... in place of the remaining names. Give Last author's name after the ellipses.

Note: The "&" is not used.

REFERENCES

CORPORATE / GOVERNMENT / AGENCY AUTHOR

Book

Corporation's Name. (Year). *Title of the book: Subtitle of the book*, (Edition). Publisher. Provide the DOI or URL if published electronically

Journal

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Note: For alphabetical purposes, ignore initial articles: "The", "A", and "An".

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Use the letters n.d. for the year.

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FORMATTING

FONT: Accessible to all users. Font options and sizes: Calibri-11, Arial-11, Times New Roman-12, Georgia-11. Same font is used throughout.

LINE SPACING: Double throughout.

COVER PAGE:

Header: Page Number only, flush with right margin.

Title: Three to four double space lines from the top, centered and bolded. Capitalize initial letters of titles.

Student's Name: Two double spaced lines below title.

Rest of the paper is double spaced.

ABSTRACT: If required, is on the second page.

Title of the Paper

Student's Name
Department's Name, College's Name

Abstract

The abstract summarizes the ideas presented and defines any acronyms and abbreviations in the paper. It is flush with the left margin, double spaced, and no more than 250 words. The keywords are indented ½ inch in from the left margin. Keywords is italicized and followed by a colon. Only the 1st keyword word is capitalized.

Keywords: Ideas, paper, paragraph

Title of the Paper

Indent the 1st line of each new paragraph. Paper's text is double spaced. There are not any blank lines between paragraphs.

IN-TEXT CITATIONS

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PARENTHETICAL [P]: Placed at the end of a sentence, before the period.

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Three or More Authors

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If the title is long, shorten it for the in-text citation. Capitalize initial letters of titles. NOTE: APA manual does not show examples for title narrative in-text citations.

- Books - Italicize the *Book's Title*.
[P]: (*Book's Title*, Publication Year).

- Article- The "Article's Title" is in quotes.
